Individual Needs & Small Class Size: We keep the student-to-teacher ratio low so that we may focus on the individual needs of the student and support each student on his or her individual pathway to success.

Inclusive, supportive school culture -Our classes are structured to provide an atmosphere of respect where students develop a deep understanding of individual differences and an acceptance for all.



Innovative instruction methods - At Cambridge International Academy, we recognize that students are on different trajectories of their learning. Our educators are skilled to scaffold information to enhance learning and to help students master skill sets so that they can smoothly transition to the next higher level. Our teachers support our students by implementing the stages of Zone of Proximal Development:

- 1. Assess the learner's current knowledge
- 2. Make new content relatable to what students already understand or can do
- 3.Break the learning into manageable tasks with opportunities for feedback
- 4.Use cues and prompts to assist students
- 5. Tasks become progressively more challenging as student gains more knowledge
- 6. Teacher gradually releases control to the student as the student approaches the level of potential learning

Our learning environment is set up to meet the various learning preferences of students. We use a complete approach, which reinforces verbal instruction with visual and written support, allowing the students to engage on many levels regarding the material being presented.

Professional and dedicated staff - Our education team of skilled teachers are talented in finding and encouraging the abilities of each student. All core subjects are taught by subject specialists.

Varied Assessments- We offer continuous, varied and appropriate formative and summative assessments which provide evidence about every student's learning progress. This information helps teachers to immediately flag areas of concern to help a student in that subject. Triangulation assessments also help students, parents and teacher to select learning goals, and Aptitude Tests help to plan further education.

Participate in Competitions- To drive student motivation, and to practice growth mindset for our students, we prepare and encourage them to participate in various academic contests in the areas of Math, Business, Public Speaking, and Writing Competitions.

Frequent and Ongoing Parent Communication: To help students attain their academic best, we communicate weekly with parents to keep them up to date with their child's progress. We communicate with parents using a variety of communicating tools such as email, newsletters, calls, and text.

















Educational Pathways to Success

Cambridge International Academy offers one to one career/life planning program from grades 9 to 12 designed to help students achieve their personal goals and become competent, successful, and contributing members of society.

Most high school students don't have a clear vision of their chosen career path and seek guidance. At Cambridge International Academy, we offer *one to one counselling*

Cambridge International Academy provides and shares a customized educational plan with the student and his/her parents. A four year customized high school educational pathway offers the student a clear vision and purpose relevant to his/her career aspirations.

Consistent, Continual Communication

The consultation continues throughout the school year, during which students have opportunities to receive advice and support. The teaching staff is also involved in the planning process to ensure students acquire the prerequisites needed to enter their chosen post secondary program. We offer students to attend off site information sessions at their preferred post-secondary institution and/or we arrange for representatives from different post secondary institutions to visit Cambridge International Academy to speak to them.

All Courses

The advantage of a four-semester term during a school year is that students are able to gain an in depth and breath of the course content. The 2.5 hour classes allow students to further engage & collaborate with one another while working on group projects, they gain additional time to do experiments and/or research, and are exposed to greater detail of the course material. In addition, students become less anxious when focusing on two courses per term and are able to pace themselves accordingly for school success.

Enriched Programs

During the year, we offer a variety of after school programs to have students explore their academic and personal interests. In addition to regular homework club to assist students to achieve the best potential for their assignments, we offer Homework Enhancer in which students are exposed to higher level materials in Math and English so that they may challenge themselves.



School Community

School Community

Many of our school activities are initiated and managed by Cambridge students themselves for social and personal development. An active student life provides students an opportunity to bond with classmates, and create experiences they can draw from now and throughout their lifetime. Valuable life lessons can be learned in extracurricular activity, like working through adversity, becoming aware of their own individual abilities and talents, developing confidence and working with people to achieve a common goal.

Clubs: Cambridge International Academy offers students the opportunity to participate in various school clubs after school or on the weekends. Clubs offered are *Art, Basketball, Coding, Homework, Literacy Test & Euclid Test Preparation, Martial Arts/Gym, Master Chef, Ping Pong, Robotics, and Speech & Debate.*

Committees: Our dedicated Yearbook & Graduation Committees of hard working students plan and organize vital services to our school community. These two committees highlight & capture memorable moments of the school year.

Competitions: School competitions teach students about determination, creativity, and perseverance to overcome challenges. Cambridge students participate in various school competitions such as UN Model, DECA, Rotman Boardroom Case Competition, and Euclid Contest.

Field Trips: Cambridge International Academy offer once a month school trips that are aligned with the Ontario Curriculum. Trips to the Salmon Migration, ROM, AGO, Toronto Zoo, Ripley's Aquarium, Science Centre, Canada's Wonderland, Dundas Peak, Lakeridge Skiing, are just a few of the activities provided to students throughout the school year. For example, students participate in a Salmon Migration Outing will describe the seasonal migration of anadromous fish like salmon and identify a variety of natural and human factors that affect the reproductive success of salmon (grade 4); students will learn about the basic fish biology and make comparisons between major organs of human to salmon (grade 5); students will learn about the different stages of the life cycle of the salmon and create a visual presentation (grade 6); students from different grade levels will also write a personal reflection about the activity.

Leadership Camp: Students participate in a two day outdoor experiential Leadership Educational Program at the YMCA Cedar Glen Outdoor Center in Schomberg. During this time, students experience the opportunity to lead others and to overcome their fears.


