
Focused Semester System

ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE

Our program allows students to learn English quickly and easily.

- We have experienced licensed teachers
- The curriculum covers the 4 vital aspects of language;

 - Speaking
 - Reading
 - ☑ Writing
- Upon arrival, students are tested for their English proficiency and are assigned to the appropriate level.



The ESL Pathway

There are 5 distinct levels and students must complete the course and pass a test to move on the the next level.

After passing DO, you can start taking Academic English. **ENG 3U ENG 4U ESL ESL ESL ESL ESL Academic Academic** CO RN no FO **English English**

These are the 2 foundational levels. The courses focus on improving English comprehension, reading speaking and writing skills. Students will work on more advanced subjects. The course includes public speaking and written essays. This level focuses on speaking English accurately and smoothly in the classroom and in social settings.

After this level, students are ready to understand English instruction and to learn fully in English. They are proficient in secondary school English.

Students can study academic courses at these levels

Students are now ready to join the regular academic English classes, which focus on consolidation of literacy and communication, as well as the critical and creative thinking skills that are necessary for success in academic and daily life.

GRADE 7&8 PROGRAM

Royal Crown is excited to continue our Grade 7 and 8 program! The Middle School Program is designed to complement the well-developed High School Program that is in place for our Grade 9-12 students. Our Middle School Program follows the Ontario Curriculum, and a robust set of courses are being offered throughout the year. Students will be taking Physical Education, Mathematics, Geography, Visual Arts, History, Drama, and Science and Technology throughout the academic year. Students will receive ongoing formative and summative feedback regarding their achievement throughout the year and achievement reports will be provided to parents at mid-term and at the end of each semester.

In order to ensure that our young learners in Grade 7 and 8 receive strong support, a well-being support program is being introduced to help our Middle School students receive guidance in goal setting, time management, as well as on strategies to enhance their learning. Further support is being introduced in our Boarding program for students who decide to live in our Boarding facility.

We believe that having our Middle School students with us will benefit our young learners and our school community. Whether student enroll in our peer-mentoring program, or have siblings in the High School Program, our Middle School students will enjoy the opportunity to interact with, and be mentored by their older peers during after school activities and clubs. We understand that supporting families in every way possible results in strong educational outcomes for students, and we are proud to be extending our grade offerings in ways that will make it easier for families to enroll their children at Royal Crown and to participate in the school community.





OUR CURRICULUM

ONTARIO SECONDARY SCHOOL DIPLOMA (OSSD)

At RCS, students receive a balanced education through the rigorous Ontario Curriculum. The Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) is granted to secondary school graduates in the Canadian province of Ontario, and is accepted by universities worldwide. Our learners complete 18 compulsory courses as a key component of the (OSSD). Students take English, French, Mathematics, Science, History, Geography, and courses within the Arts, as well as Civics and Career studies as they prepare for their roles as responsible citizens.

Students also complete 12 optional courses that may be choosen from a robust range of subjects offered at our School.

OUR TEACHING PHILOSOPHY

The academic standards at Royal Crown are high, and with high expectations comes high support. Students learn subject area content along with their peers, and extend this learning through close collaboration with the teacher and with each other during group work and projects. Students have the opportunity to focus, in-depth, on two subjects each semester, and our philosophy of teach-learn-teach ensures that students understand assessment criteria and receive ongoing feedback on their academic performance.

Learning extends beyond the classroom as students participate in after-school activities, internships, service work, and contact with international student organizations. These experiences help to deepen and consolidate learning that is acquired in the classroom. They also let students develop leadership skills. This year, activities such as the Model United Nations, medical internships, and environmental clubs are planned.

University Counseling

Royal Crown will work with each student to help select the right university for them. Our education professionals introduce students to universities and their specialty departments as well as counsel students on programs of studies and future career opportunities. Our university counsellors will also ensure that application packages are properly prepared and submitted timely to ensure the greatest chance of acceptance into the top university of their choice.

Course Selection

We ensure that each student gets the most out of their high school experience by guiding them to select the right courses for them and take advantage of what the school experience has to offer with co-curriculars, internships and other new educational or leadership experiences.

Extended Health Insurance

Royal Crown provides international students with comprehensive health insurance with maximum coverage. Clinical visits, hospitalization and prescription drugs are covered.

Constant Monitoring

Because of our intimate classroom setting, our teachers and staff are able to constantly monitor the academic progress of each individual student. Our caring staff also monitor emotional wellbeing and mental health to ensure that each student is happy and thriving.

STEP 1

Complete and submit application form to admissions@royalcrownschool.com



STEP 2

Provide Royal Crown with transcripts and report cards from previous institutions for the last three years.



STEP 3

The Royal Crown Admissions team will conduct an interview with the applicant. This can be done in person or via Zoom.



STEP 4

After evaluating applicant's eligibility and fit, Royal Crown School will issue a conditional Letter of Acceptance.



STEP 5

Applicants will accept their offer by signing and submitting their Letter of Acceptance and full payment of tuition.
