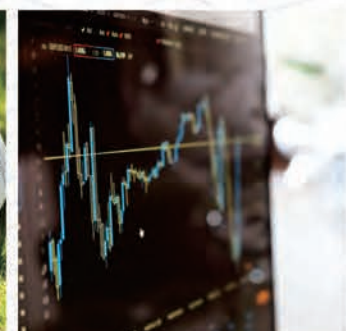
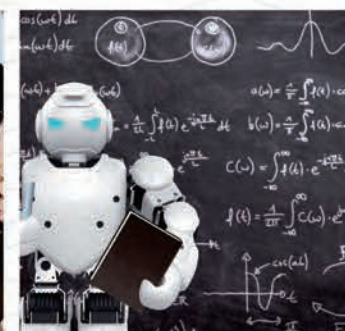
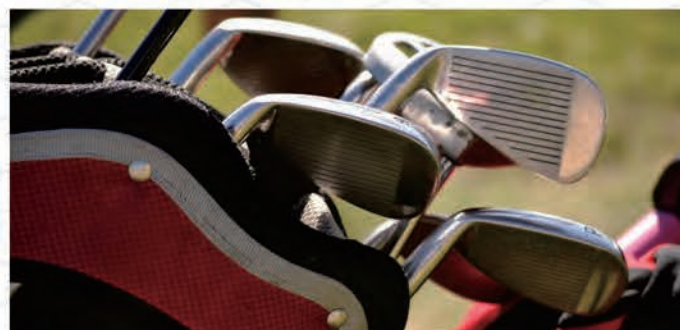






## Our Mission

New students always face new challenges. This is normal. But what makes an exceptional student is not the challenges they face; it is how they deal with those challenges, while still moving forward, that results in their success.

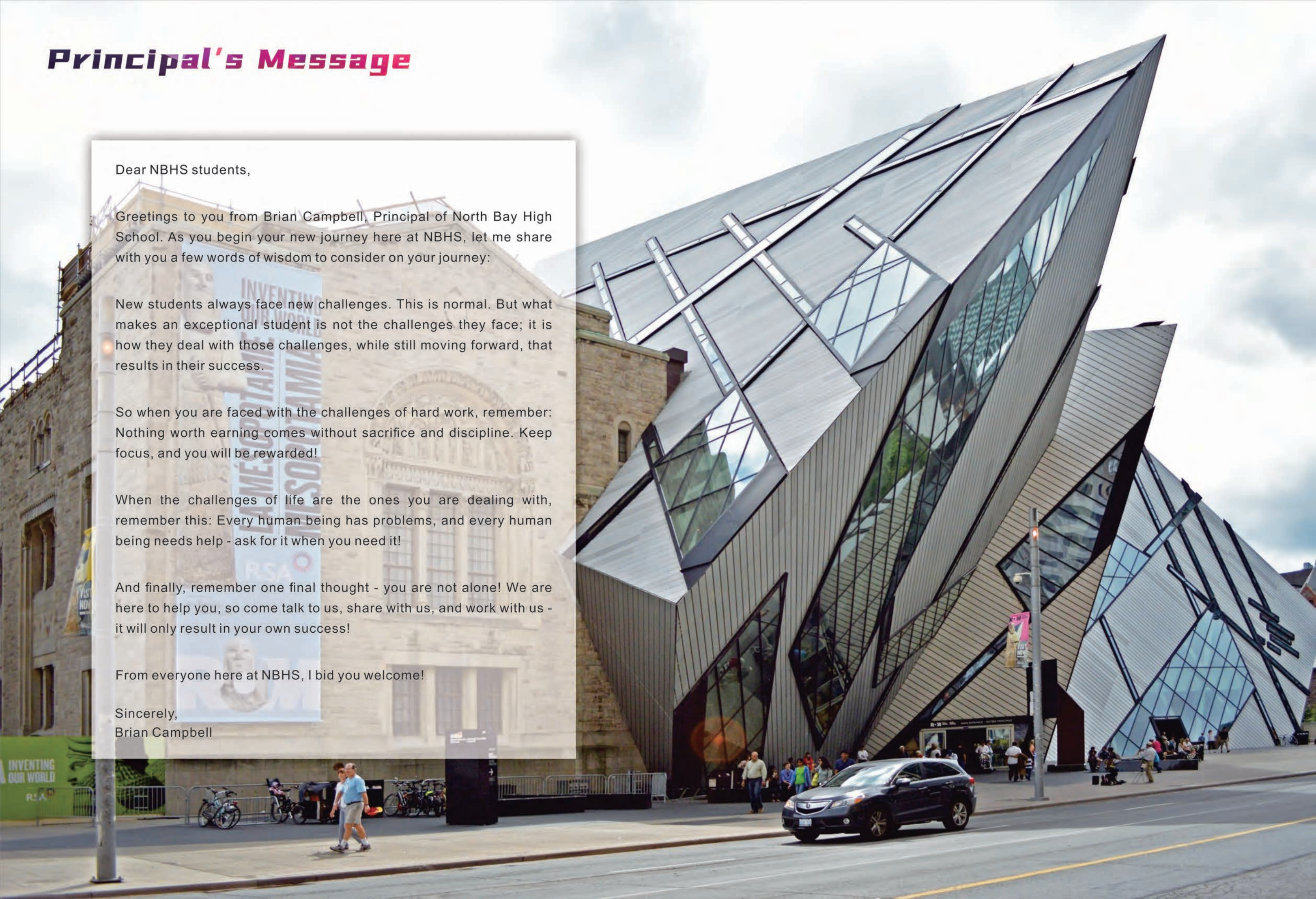
So when you are faced with the challenges of hard work, remember: Nothing worth earning comes without sacrifice and discipline. Keep focus, and you will be rewarded!

The Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) is a legal certificate of graduation awarded to high school graduates in Ontario, Canada. The OSSD is designed to be a comprehensive measure of the quality of education and social practice that a student receives in secondary school. It requires that the student achieve a set number of credits in a multi-disciplinary program of compulsory and elective courses, that the student pass the Ontario Standardized Test, OSSLT. They also need to complete a certain number of hours of volunteer work before they can receive their OSSD diploma.



Credit courses will be adjusted based on students' enrollment status.

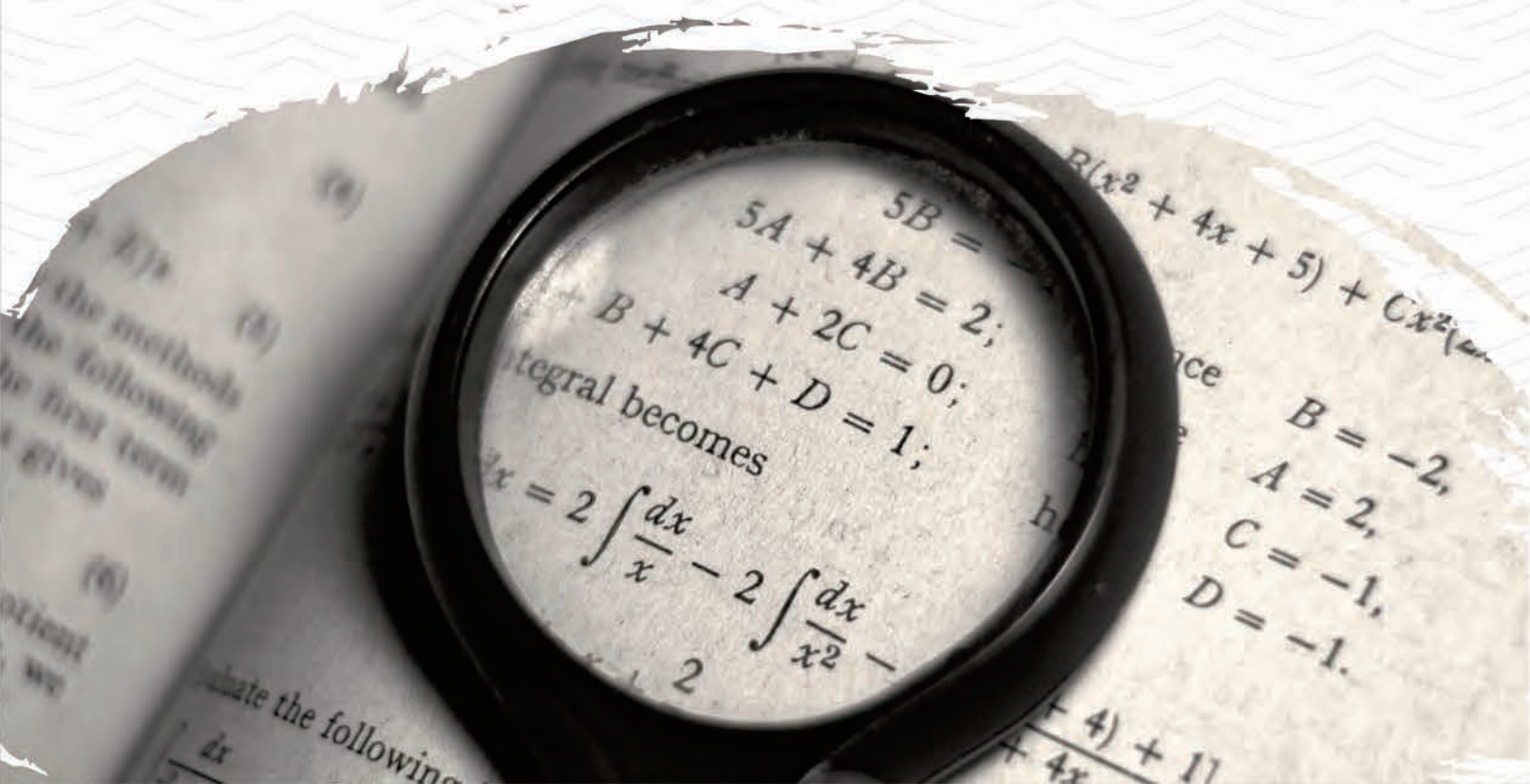
## Math Club

## Multisports

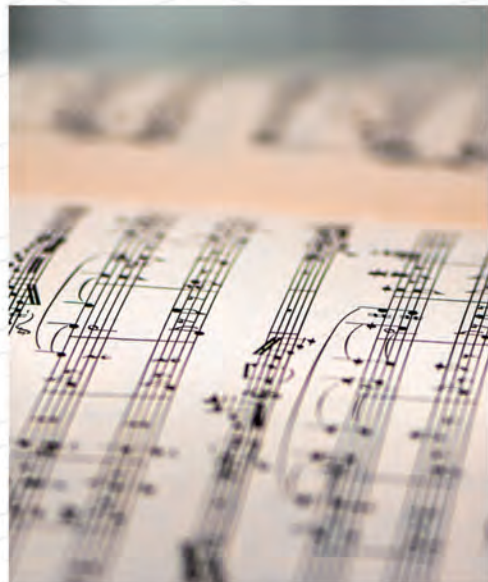

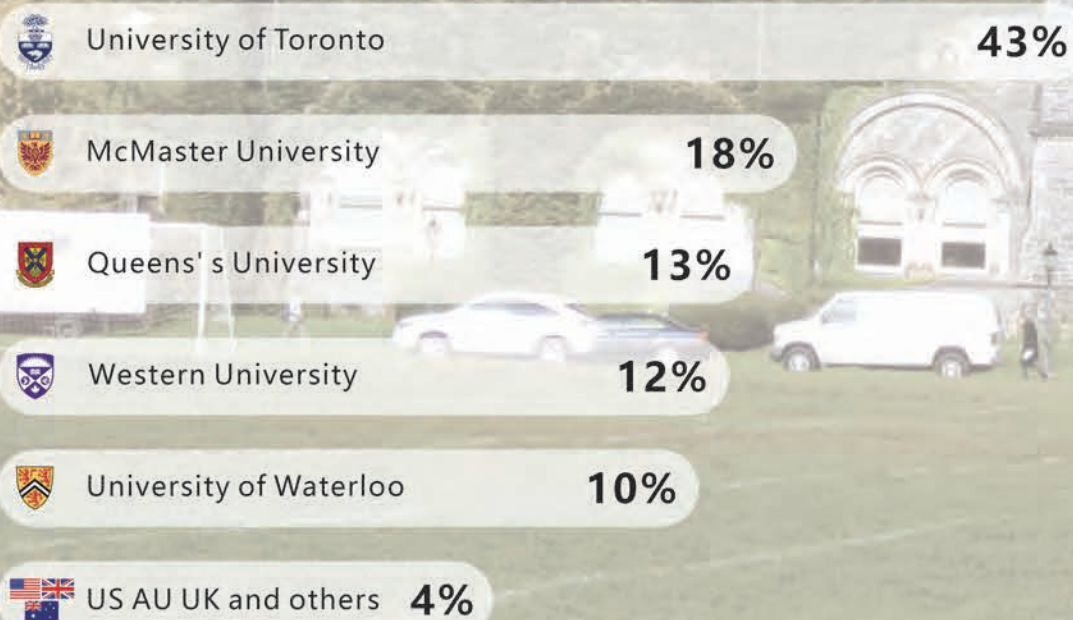
