For our creatively gifted student body we provide year long opportunities to bring their vision to life through art showcases and highly anticipated Film Festival.

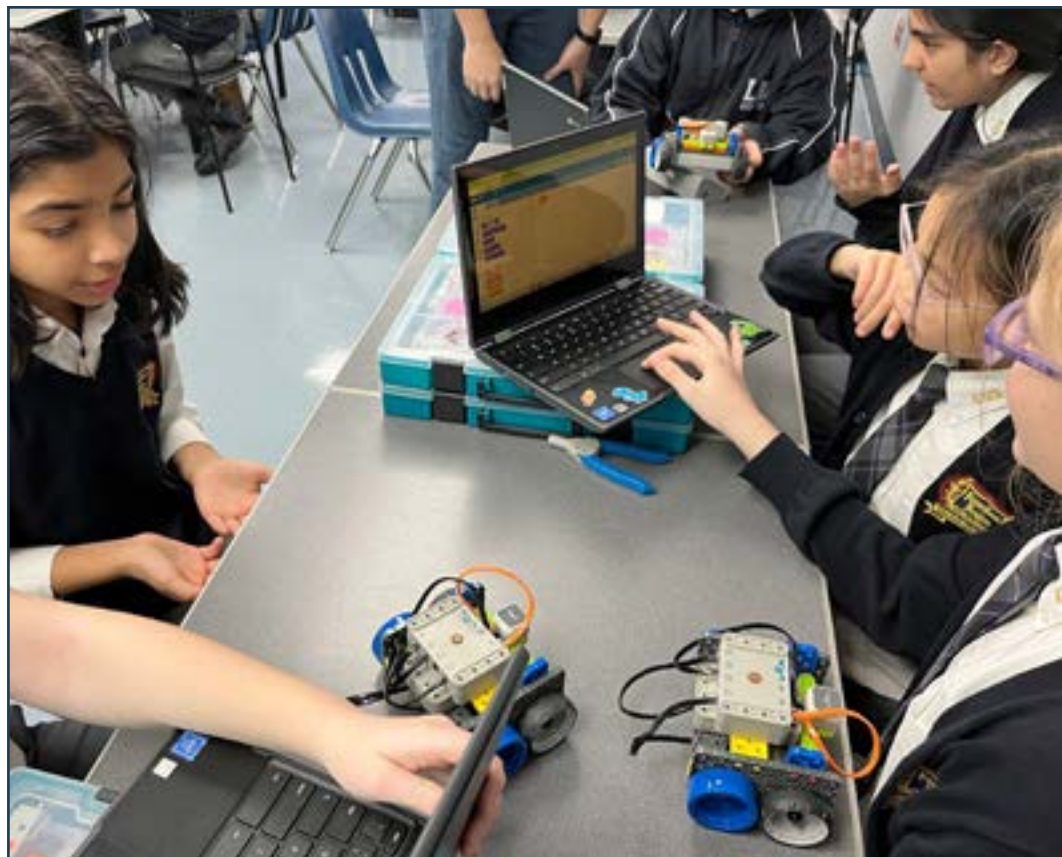
The robotics club at LRS has attracted a high interest over the years as our students learn to design, code and compete their robots against their peers.

# ADMISSIONS PROCESS

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## Step 1: Online Application Form

Complete the [online application form](#) and provide the required documents:

- ◆ Last two report cards. Not applicable for Junior Kindergarten Students.
- ◆ Up to date immunization records.
- ◆ Passport OR Birth Certificate.

## Step 2: Teacher Recommendation

Upon receiving the completed application form with the required documents our team will do a thorough review and email a confidential teacher recommendation form to the individual listed within the application form.

Not applicable for Junior Kindergarten students.

## Step 3: Admissions Interview

Students' applying for grade 4 to 12 that meet our initial criteria will be invited for a virtual admissions interview with a member of the Senior Leadership Team.

Students' applying for Kindergarten to grade 3 will receive an admissions decision once step 1 and 2 have been successfully completed.

## Step 4: Decision

The admissions team will provide families with an admissions decision upon completion of the above steps.

Admissions for each year is on a rolling basis and dependent on available seats after re-enrollment. Priority of acceptance is provided on application submission date. Lynn-Rose does provide priority admissions for siblings.
