LOWER SCHOOL (JK to 5)

Classes provide a safe, inviting atmosphere in which to set the foundational skills important for lifelong learning.

From Kindergarten, we respect that children are intellectually capable and enjoy conveying their thoughts through speaking and writing.

Because physical, social, emotional and cognitive development are equally important and influence each other strongly in young children, the curriculum is integrated and hands-on.

Room is made for individual differences. Questioning, communication and collaboration are cultivated increasingly by working together in the classroom.

MIDDLE SCHOOL (6 to 8)

Children of Middle School age are in dramatic change and require an environment that assists in self-discovery and appreciates their high energy, humour and desire for self-determination.

The emphasis on academics broadens, deepens and consolidates skills for the specialized learning of secondary school. This includes a focus on work skills and study habits.

Middle School teachers are trained in their subject to challenge each student.

Socially, teachers seek to provide self-confidence and positive identity, to develop greater understanding of human relationships, to encourage realistic goal setting and to inspire social consciousness.

Middle School students receive weekly guidance lessons for mentorship and support.





Co-Curricular Activities

Matthews Hall has many opportunities for students. Children learn and grow when they are engaged together in something productive (e.g., club meetings, sporting events, performances, campaigns, and gatherings).
