Pedagogy with Purpose.

Success at The Clover School is four-fold: academic mastery, the ability to think creatively, mindfulness and social intelligence, and positive connectedness with the world around us. In addition to Montessori fundamentals. our signature Clover School curriculum features unique programming elements to create a purpose-filled pedagogy that helps each child thrive.

Outdoor Education

A connectedness to nature and the physical world around us is essential to our wellbeing, but today's children are at risk of becoming disconnected from the natural world. Outdoor Education offers children the chance to cultivate real world skills, understand our deeply rooted interdependence with nature, receive immediate feedback from the elements, build confidence and resilience, and act as proud stewards of the environment. The Clover School makes a space for experiential outdoor learning with bi-weekly, year-round nature days where students and teachers venture out to local sites for collaborative, adventure-based programming.

Urban Farming

Each of our schools is equipped with an on-campus Edible Lab, managed and maintained by the students themselves under the quidance of our full-time resident Urban Farming Specialist. The Urban Farm expands on our science curriculum, exposing children to a variety of interconnected learning opportunities, from cooking and nutrition to hosting a Farmers' Market. This fosters environmental and food source awareness while also providing a small business education. Students gain a sense of purpose as they work together to achieve their goals with tangible results.

Entrepreneurship

Today's children are tomorrow's change-makers. It's important to foster innovative thinking early on, so we integrate entrepreneurial education into everyday classroom life. We focus on the development of skills that students can use to realize opportunities, develop ideas, acumen, and independent thinking. We encourage innovation, risktaking, and clever problem solving. setting our students up for success in the future. Students actively collaborate to build and support micro-economies, organize and event plan, and set up fundraising initiatives to realize their goals and dreams.





Arts and Culture

Our Primary Montessori program provides a joyful and nurturing environment that is designed to strengthen the 3-to-6-year-old child's independence, social skills, academic foundation, and self-confidence while cultivating creativity, curiosity, and love of learning.

Imagine a room filled with children engaged in active learning, independently or in collaboration with others. It's alive with focused activity while a highly-skilled teacher observes, gently guiding and supporting students when needed. Welcome to The Clover School's Primary classroom. These bright and friendly, mixed-age environments are lively and upbeat, buzzing with active and engaged 3-to-6-year-old learners.

With a carefully sequenced and mastery-based curriculum, children are taken through a sensorial learning experience that helps set a solid foundational core in subjects like

Reading, Writing, and Mathematics. Their imaginations and innate curiosity are fuelled by deeply engaging lessons in Science, History, Geography, Music, and the Arts.

Our Montessori-trained teachers provide thoughtful guidance to each individual student, foster self-directed learning, nurture social and emotional growth, and encourage children to take a heart-centred approach to all they do. Children have uninterrupted time for deep concentration and concrete collaborative peer-to-peer learning in an environment equipped with scientifically designed Montessori learning materials.



Elementary Program

Our Elementary Montessori program features a classroom environment designed to facilitate intellectual growth, academic excellence, and social emotional learning for students in grades 1 through 6. Creativity, collaboration, and entrepreneurial thinking are encouraged by our project-based learning model and integrated curriculum.

The Clover School's Montessori Elementary program supports children from 6 through 12 years of age, when a child's curiosity is exponential. As educators, our role is to foster that exponential curiosity and channel it towards key subjects and impactful learning experiences. Our students love to learn, socialize, explore, research, plan, and execute projects and engage with community and the wider world around them in meaningful ways and with purpose. Our Elementary classrooms are carefully designed to facilitate abstract learning with a curriculum that often exceeds grade-level requirements pursuant to the provincial standards.

Lower Elementary (grades 1 to 3) and Upper Elementary (grades 4 to 6) students continue to enjoy the role modelling and mentoring advantages of working together in multi-age environments. These mixed-age classroom groups allow for meaningful relationships to develop between teachers and their students, which is integral to a positive learning experience. Younger students have the advantage of learning alongside their older classmates who serve as trusted mentors and leaders in the classroom. Older students blossom in confidence and leadership skills by embracing their role as senior students.

Visit The Clover School

The admissions process is designed to help you learn as much as possible about our school and help us get to know you and your child.

Apply

Applications are submitted through our online portal. We will send you a link inviting you to apply once you have completed your tour. If you are unable to attend a tour session, we are happy to schedule a virtual tour to answer any questions you might have prior to applying. All new applicants must pay a onetime Application Fee of \$500. The application form and the Application Fee must be received in order for us to begin processing your application. Once our admissions department has had a chance to review your application, we will contact you directly to confirm application status and to discuss next steps for admission and enrollment.



Admission

Admission is on a first come, first served basis for our Toddler to Primary programs. Returning and former students, their siblings, and those previously enrolled in other Montessori schools are given priority. New families applying to our Elementary and Middle School programs (Grades 1 through 8) will be asked to provide additional paperwork upon application, including past report cards, and any educational/ behavioural assessments your child may have had. Accompanying paperwork can be sent in via email to our Admissions Director at admissions@cloverschool.com. Upon receipt of this information, your family will be invited to come in for an assessment/interview/ visit day to determine your child's suitability for the program.


