Dynamic Assessment

To understand the Oxford Learning difference is to first understand our Dynamic Assessment.

The Oxford Learning Dynamic Assessment measures your child's academic achievement, and potential, learning and thinking style, as well as strengths and challenges.

This Oxford Learning Dynamic Assessment measures skill and potential, such as perceptual strengths and weaknesses, oral language inventory and use, nonverbal problem-solving intelligence, a complete array of cognitive skills and academic achievement levels.

A child can only reach his/her potential if an active mind is created. An active mind develops in a motivated child who has self-esteem and confidence. By using our dynamic relationship assessment models, we will determine the most appropriate means of working with your child from the first weeks of the school year.

We Cater Our Teaching to Your Child's Needs



Visual Learners

Visual learners process and integrate information best when presented in a visual manner; meaning that they need to see that material with their own eyes to fully understand the material that they are learning.

At OLA, we use a variety of different visual methods to stimulate the minds of our visual learners. We use charts, diagrams, films and videos—not to mention our Smartboard technology—in order for the visual learner to best comprehend the material being taught in the classroom.



Auditory Learners

Auditory learners process and integrate information best in an auditory manner; meaning that they need to hear or listen to fully understand the material that they are learning.

At OLA, we use lectures/lessons and repetition of information and instructions to ensure that the auditory learner comprehends the material being taught in the classroom.



Kinesthetic/Tactile Learners

Kinesthetic/Tactile learners process information best using their fine and gross motor skills; meaning that they need to touch and/or do in order to fully understand the material that they are learning.

At OLA, we use manipulatives and active movement to ensure that the kinesthetic/tactile learner is able to comprehend the information being presented in the classroom.

Every second year, our grades 7-8 students are able to attend either the Ottawa or Montreal trip for three days and two nights.


Events
