## BURSARY SUPPORT

UTS admits qualified students regardless of their financial circumstances and actively seeks students from varied socio-economic backgrounds. Our bursary support program is one of the largest among independent schools in Canada and annually awards over \$1.9 million in bursary support to around 15% of students. Bursary applications are evaluated separately from the Admissions applications.


